Home Cage Monitoring is available for the measurement of normal and abnormal behavior in mice and rats. Animals are typically kept in their home cage as a trained experimenter observes the animal, though a variety of experiments can be designed based on the model needs. Our experimenters are trained to monitor health status, hyperactivity, locomotive abilities, neurodegeneration, seizures, and many other parameters. The Animal Phenotyping Core houses many of these units.
